Each bid containing technical and financial proposal as per Rule 38(1) "Single Stage One Envelope Bidding Procedure", of the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 must be accompanied by bid security in shape of C.D.R worth **Rs. 14400/-** (refundable) which is 03% of the estimated value of the article(s) in the name of the Registrar, Lahore High Court, Lahore. The bidders shall also provide proof of financial soundness and registration of firm/company with the Sales Tax/Income Tax Department and professional Tax certificate.



Note: - Please read the following note and instructions carefully:-

Any proposal (Technical/Financial) not received as per terms and conditions of the Tender Enquiry is liable to be ignored. No offer shall be considered if;

- i). Received without bid security in the shape of CDR/Bank Guarantee from a scheduled bank.
  - ii). Received after the time and date fixed for its receipt.
  - iii). The proposal is unsigned.
  - iv). The proposal is ambiguous.
  - v). The proposal is conditional.
  - vi). The proposal is from a firm blacklisted, suspended or removed from the approved list.
  - vii). The proposal received is of a shorter validity than required in the tender enquiry.
  - viii). The proposal is for item(s) not conforming to specifications indicated in the tender enquiry.
2. Offer must remain valid for 60 days from the date of opening the proposal.
  3. All proposals must be submitted in double cover. The outer cover should indicate the name of the addressee, tender number and date of opening but not the name of the firm, which must appear in the inner envelope clearly mentioning tender number and name of the firm. The envelope must be properly sealed.
  4. Each bid shall comprise a single package containing technical & financial proposal, in terms of Rule (38)(1), Single Stage One Envelope Bidding Procedure, of the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.
  5. The Purchaser reserves the right to purchase full or part of the item(s) or ignore/scrap/cancel the tender, recording reasons thereof.
  6. Further the following would apply.
    - (a). If the acceptance of tender issued during the validity period of the proposal is not accepted by the tenderer, the bid security shall be forfeited and the item(s) purchased would be at his (tenderer's) risk and expense.
    - (b). In case the offer is withdrawn/amended or revised during the validity period of the offer, the Bid security is liable to be forfeited.
    - (c). In case the contractor fails to execute the contract strictly in accordance with terms and conditions laid down in the contract the security deposited (CDR) by him shall be forfeited and the item(s) purchased would be at his risk and expense.
  7. The buyer reserves the right to claim compensation for the loss caused by the delay in the work, as determined by the buyer.

**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. The work is required to be completed within the time given in the work order. However, the bidders are required to indicate their own guaranteed earliest date by which the work will be done.
2. Bidders must quote their financial proposal on the detail of items intended to be procured. Cash Receipts (in original or photo copy) in token of having purchased the tender, must accompany the proposal.
3. Bids/proposals should be addressed to the **Registrar, Lahore High Court, Lahore.**
4. Bidders should quote their firm and final rates both in words, as well as in figures (inclusive of all taxes).
5. Bidders shall submit a bid security in the shape of CDR/Bank guarantee amounting to **Rs.14400/-** which is 3% of the estimated cost of procurement in favour of the Registrar, Lahore High Court, Lahore.
6. The successful bidders shall be required to furnish 10% of the total value as performance Bank Guarantee in favour of **Registrar, Lahore High Court, Lahore** (by designation only) for a period of one year from the date of acceptance of the bids, failing which the repurchase shall be made at his risk and expense.
7. In case of Indigenous item(s) the tenderers who are manufacturers must indicate name and address of their works in Pakistan from where they intend to supply the item(s).
8. Bidder must be an authorized service provider of the Principal. In case of international warranty, the local authorized dealer should mention their services and warranty setup.
9. "This is to certify that M/s. \_\_\_\_\_ have obtained quotation to Tender No. \_\_\_\_\_ due on \_\_\_\_\_ and bidder shall carry out supply/manufacture the said item(s) in accordance with the specifications laid down in the invitation to tender".
10. Any conditional, ambiguous or incomplete proposal in any respect shall be ignored. No supplementary or revised offer after opening of bids shall be entertained.
11. The bidders should indicate in their bids, complete address or the place/places where item(s) will be offered for inspection.
12. The bidders shall enclose catalogues/leaflets/literature and other technical data, if any, in respect of item(s) offered by them.
13. The bidders should specifically indicate their NTN/GST No. and circle of the Income-Tax Department.
