

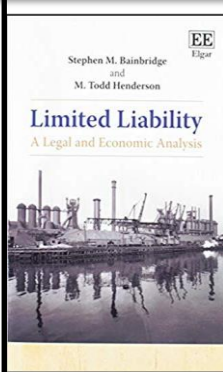

BOOKS AVAILABLE IN LIBRARY COLLECTION

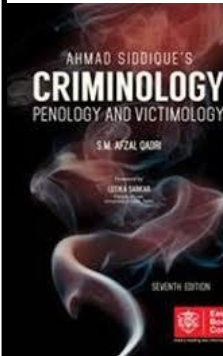

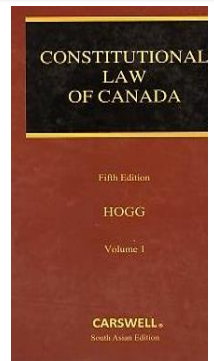

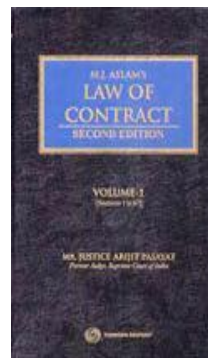
CONSTITUTIONAL LAW OF CANADA, PETER W. HOGG, THOMSON REUTERS, 2017

However, there are many references to the constitutional law of the United Kingdom, New Zealand, Australia and the United States. The American Bill of Rights is included as an appendix. The International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights is also included as an appendix, and some reference is made to that instrument and other international human rights instruments and their jurisprudential exegesis. The new edition of Constitutional Law of Canada includes three new chapters which provide more extensive treatment to issues that were covered only interstitially in the fourth edition.

Restatement topics are supplemented by annotations gathered in appendix volumes within the set. While restatements state the law as it is, principles examine and analyze legal areas thought to need reform, expressing the law as it should be. Restatements and principles provide authoritative sources of authority supporting a client's position.
