- (ii) The candidates are allowed to bring Bare Acts/copies of High Court Rules & Orders as permitted in Schedule-I to the Punjab Additional District & Sessions Judges (Departmental Examination) Rules, 2014 for Paper-1 (Criminal Law-I, Substantive), Paper-3 (Civil Law-I, Substantive), Paper-5 (High Court Rules and Orders, Service Laws and Accounts), Paper-6 (Special Laws (Banking, Anti-Corruption, Labour, Consumer, Anti-Terrorism Law) and Paper-7 (Constitution of Pakistan).
- (iii) It may also be added that the examinee(s) have to bring their own Bare Acts etc. for use in the paper(s) in which the bare acts etc are allowed but without commentary and notes written thereon.
- (iv) Candidate(s) found using material other than the permissible reference books or indulging in unfair means will be liable to

disciplinary action under the Rules which may include disqualification in the relevant paper/entire Examination.
